**Welcome** to a new school year. I am very excited to be working with your child at this special time in their life. In first grade your child will learn the vital and fundamental skills of reading, mathematics, and social behavior.



I believe that children have a desire to work and behave appropriately as we clearly communicate those expectations to them. I reinforce the importance of building stamina (time on task) so that I can do my job -

teach your children, and they can do their job - learn. We are all entitled to a safe, learning atmosphere which will help us accomplish our jobs. *Please be patient as we all learn the social norms for distancing and hygiene routines*.

<u>*Hybrid Schedule:*</u> During the first two weeks of school or longer, I will be explicitly teaching and practicing face-to-face and distance learning. I will ensure that students are prepared to work at home when your children are ready - sometime after Labor Day. Until then, I will send paper assignments.

**<u>First Day of School</u>**: August 25<sup>th</sup> or 26<sup>th</sup> your child is expected to arrive wearing a face mask at 8:40 to line up at the west end of our building on a circle to help with distancing. Teachers will be there to greet the students. Your child will leave to go home in the same area. Please make sure to let those who need to meet up your child have this information. All students will be provided a mask. If you need it before the first day, contact the school for an appointment.

<u>Sick or ill students</u> need to stay home. If your child is or becomes ill at school, they will be escorted to the health room and you will be contacted.

**Consequences for <u>not following</u> class rules:** 1 Reminded of expected behavior.

3 Put head down.
4 Miss a recess or specialty class.
5 Parents contacted for further consequences.
6 Visit with Mrs. Thomas or Mr. Spencer.

**By the end of First Grade** your child will be expected to fluently read 1<sup>st</sup> grade passages and 107 Zeno sight words, write sentences using legible handwriting and correctly write the numbers 1 to 120.

**Drínkíng Fountaín & Restroom** vísits are to take place during recesses. Students will be excused from class upon request only as needed.

<u>Homework</u> Review any papers from school and redo when needed. Have your child **read** for 20 minutes daily (100 total minutes per week) including 5-10 Zeno sight words per week. Record their minutes in CANVAS.

<u>Bírthdays</u> You are welcome to come to our classroom to help us celebrate your child's birthday (under strict regulations) or you may send: photos, favorite book, token or prize, etc. Treats are discouraged due to Covid-19, severe allergies, and sugar intolerance of some students. If sent, treats need to be store bought and individually wrapped. (No donuts, cupcakes, etc.) Summer birthdays will be celebrated near your child's half-birthday.

**<u>Parent Help</u>** Your service will be greatly appreciated. Information will be sent once the school has protocols in place.
