

Third Grade 2020-2021

Welcome to third grade! We want your child to have a fun and profitable experience this year!



1. Children are expected to wear their mask every day.
2. Online learning tasks at home are expected to be completed and returned to the teacher on time. These assignments will be included as part of your child's report card grades.
3. Children should stay home if they are sick. If they become sick while at school, they will be escorted to the health room and parents will be contacted to pick up their child.
4. Children should not arrive at school more than 10 minutes before the start of school unless they are involved in the before school program or are having breakfast at school. Once the late bell rings, the children will have to check into the office before coming to class. Please help your child arrive on time every day.
5. If you need to pick up your child early from school, please go to the office and not the classroom. Once you've checked your child out, the secretary will call us, and we will send your child to the office to meet you.
6. Social skills are an important part of the learning process and a little discomfort is normal. If your child has been sent to the office for a serious infraction (safe school violation, vandalism, or extreme disruption), we will call and discuss the situation with you.
7. School supplies will be provided. Toys are a distraction. If toys are brought to school, the teacher will take them away.
8. Birthdays (half birthdays for children with summer birthdays) will be recognized. It is against district policy for students to hand out invitations to birthday parties at school.
9. Please help your child dress appropriately for school. Shoes that come off easily (flip flops) should not be worn to school. Children need shoes that allow them to run and jump.
