

## BOOKOPOLY RULES

- Kindergarten – 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade: Students can use picture books. Books can be read to them by parents. Books read by teachers do not count. Books read in prior school years do not count. Books should be on grade level. Books must be checked out from Adelaide's library unless prior permission has been requested.
- 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> Grade: Must use **chapter books** on the student's grade level – students unable to read on grade level or who are on reading IEP's may use picture books as per teacher's discretion. Please let librarian know those students who will not be using chapter books. Books read in prior school years do not count. Books read by teachers do not count. Graphic novels and non-fiction books do not count. Chapter books read must be checked out from Adelaide's library unless prior permission has been requested.
- Student must come to the library to report which property they have read. They will need to be able to answer questions about the book they read. I will be keeping track of who has read what property in case teachers would like to use it as a reading score.
- The student will be given a bookmark for the first property he/she reads.
- The student will be given a pencil for the 5<sup>th</sup> property he/she reads.
- The student will be given a raffle ticket for every group of properties (all three of the Title properties, all three of the Genre properties, etc.) they read. The raffle ticket will give them a chance to win a prize during a monthly drawing.
- After a student has read all 22 properties, they are eligible to try for "Chance" and "Book Challenge" cards. The student will receive a 50 point ticket for each of the Chance and Book Challenge books that they read. Once a student has enough credits, they can choose a book of their choice.
